

Senior Project Process

1. All proposed project ideas must be communicated to Stephanie Cunningham, Director of Outreach & Comprehensive Advocacy, via phone or e-mail.
2. If a project appears to be a good fit for Turning Point, Stephanie will set up a meeting with the student. If the project appears to be a better fit for another organization, Stephanie will refer the student to that organization.
3. When a meeting is scheduled, ideas and the timeline for the project will be discussed to determine project approval.
4. Once the project is approved, Stephanie will match the student with a mentor. All Senior Projects completed for Turning Point must be mentored by a Turning Point Staff/Board Member. Stephanie will match the student to a Turning Point Staff/Board Member whose area of expertise best fits the project.
5. Students are encouraged to meet with their mentor monthly to discuss the progress of their project and to communicate with the mentor for guidance as needed. Stephanie will check with mentors periodically to discuss the progress of the project. If there are any concerns, Stephanie and the mentor will reach out to the Senior Project Coordinator at the student's school.
